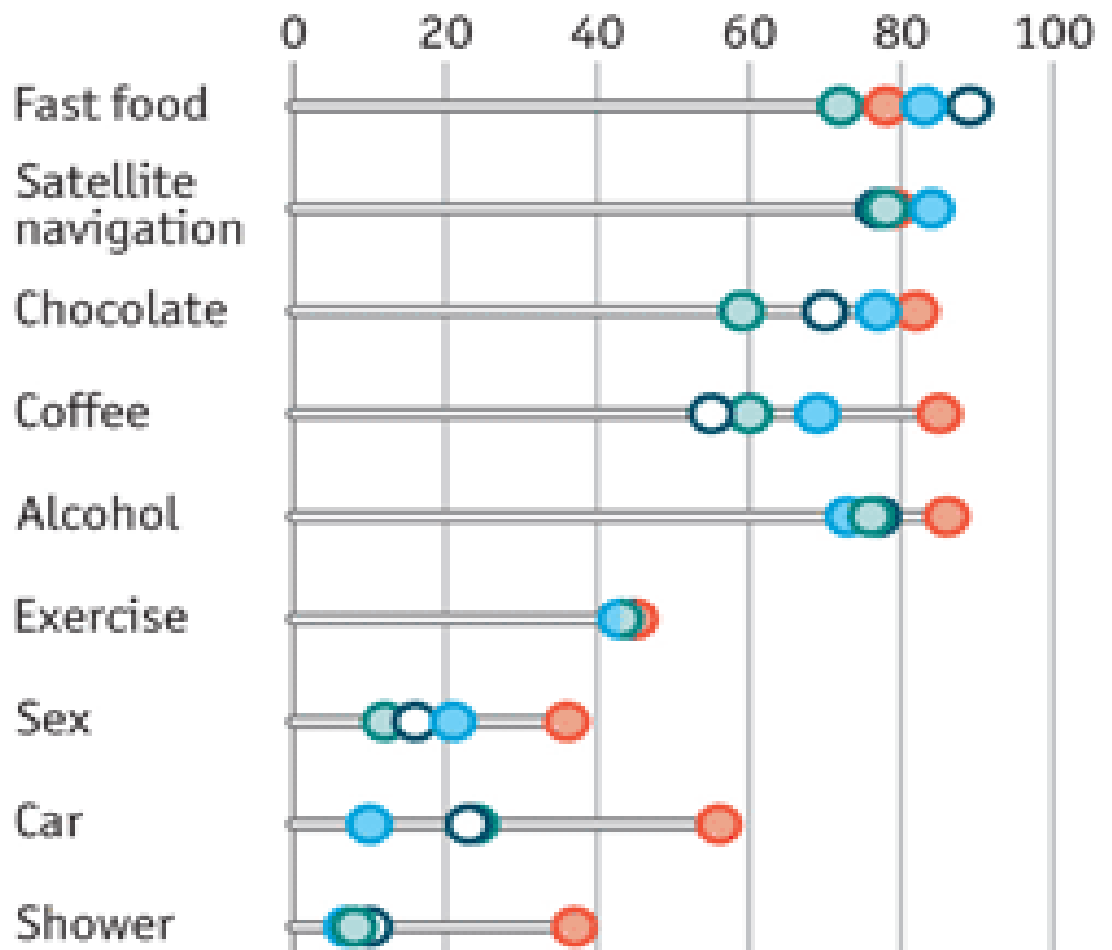
- Involved in e-diplomacy since **1992** (as part of the Mediterranean Academy of Diplomatic Studies)

● United States ● China ● Germany ● Brazil

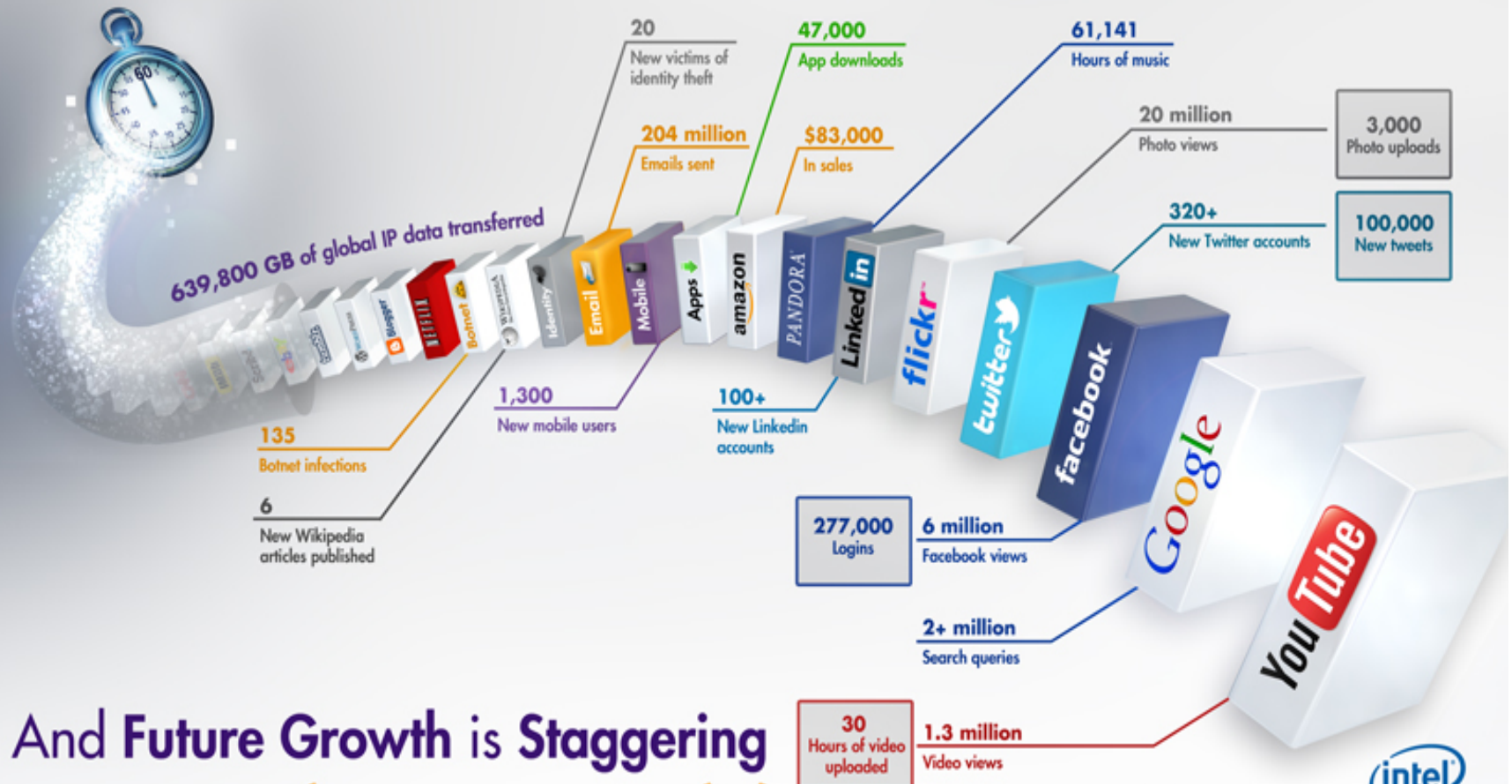

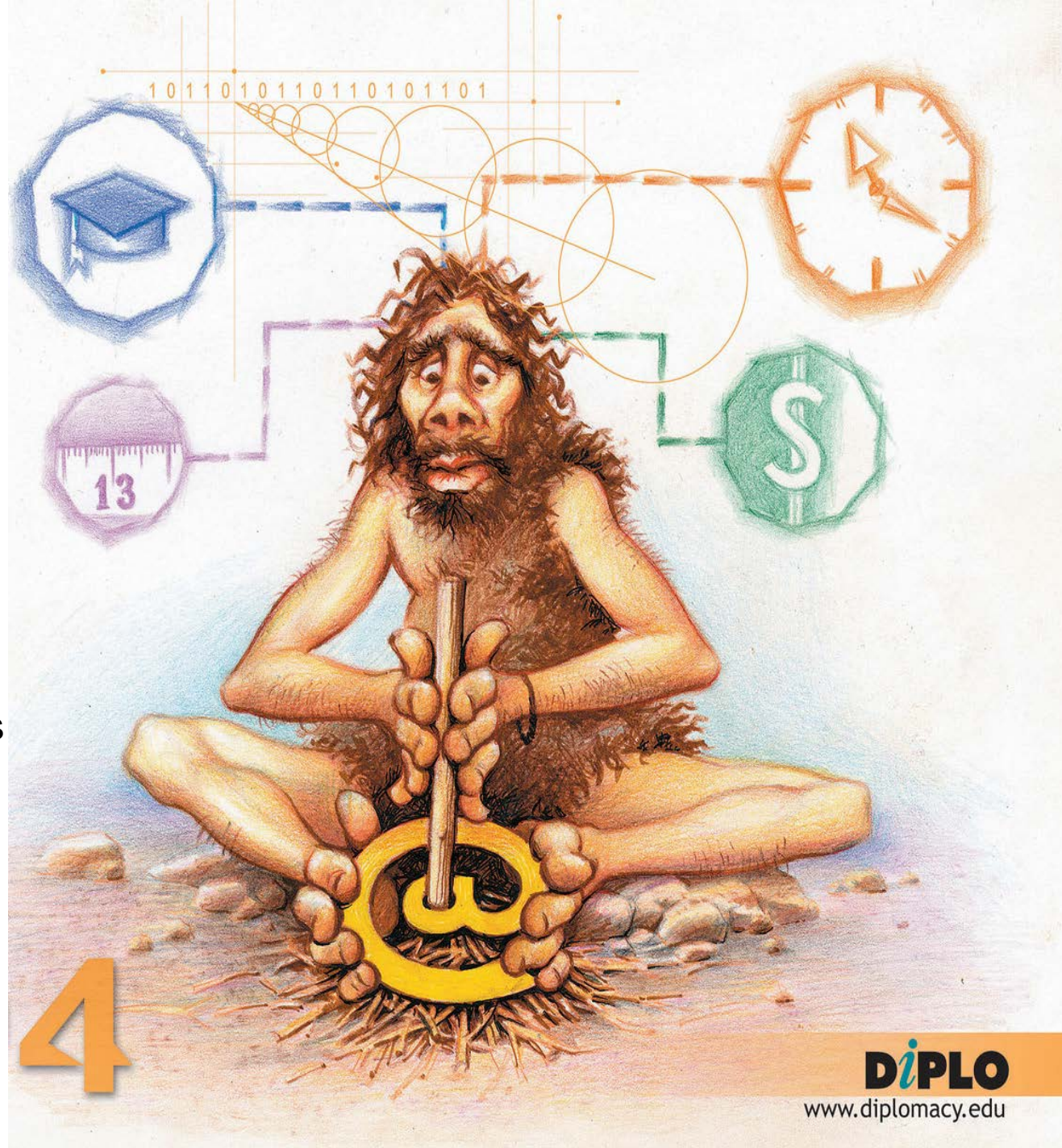


And Future Growth is Staggering

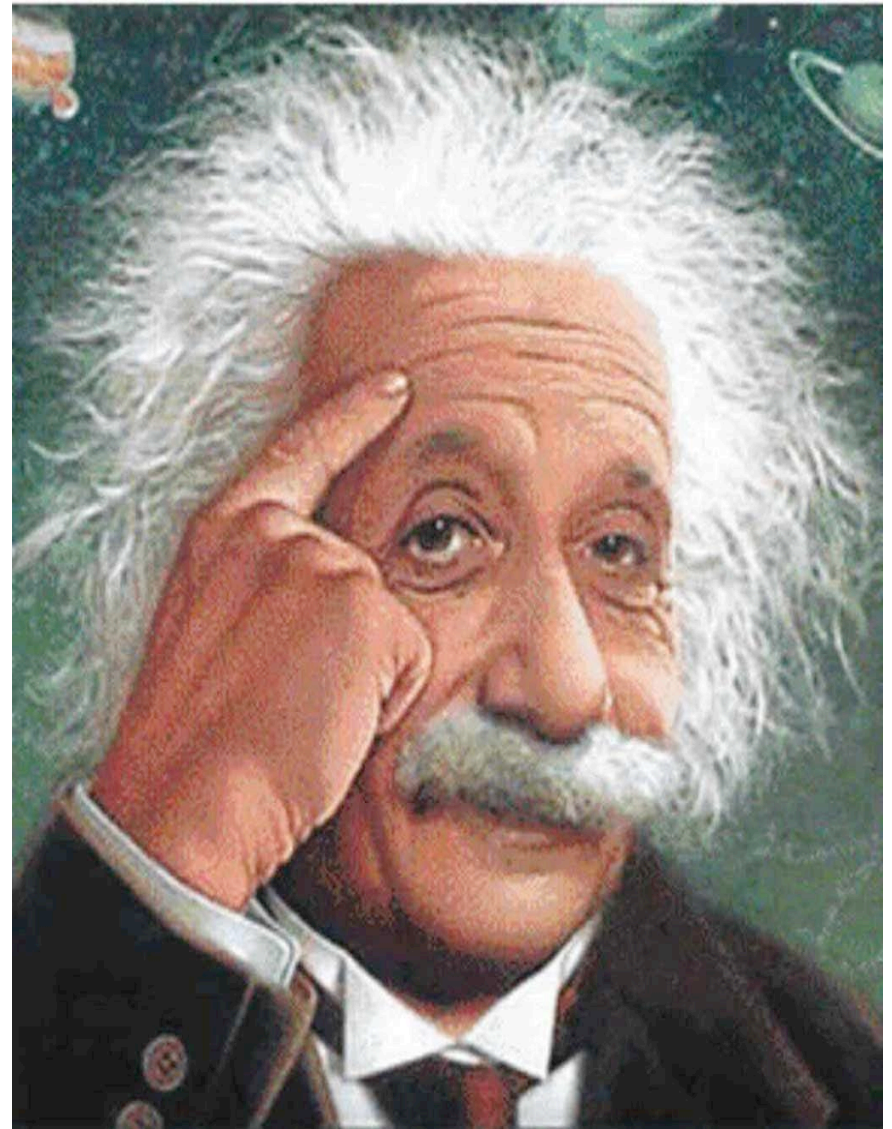

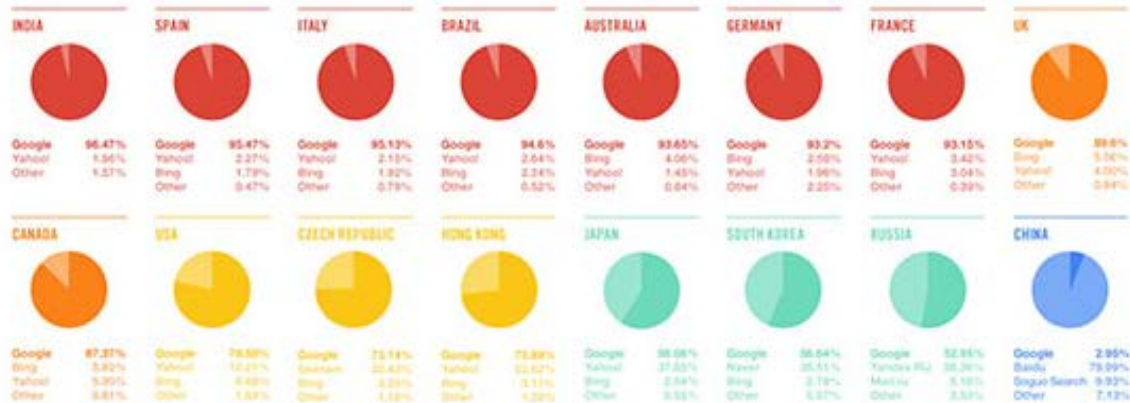


What means 'Truths' in science ?

GLOBAL SEARCH ENGINE MARKET SHARE - 2015

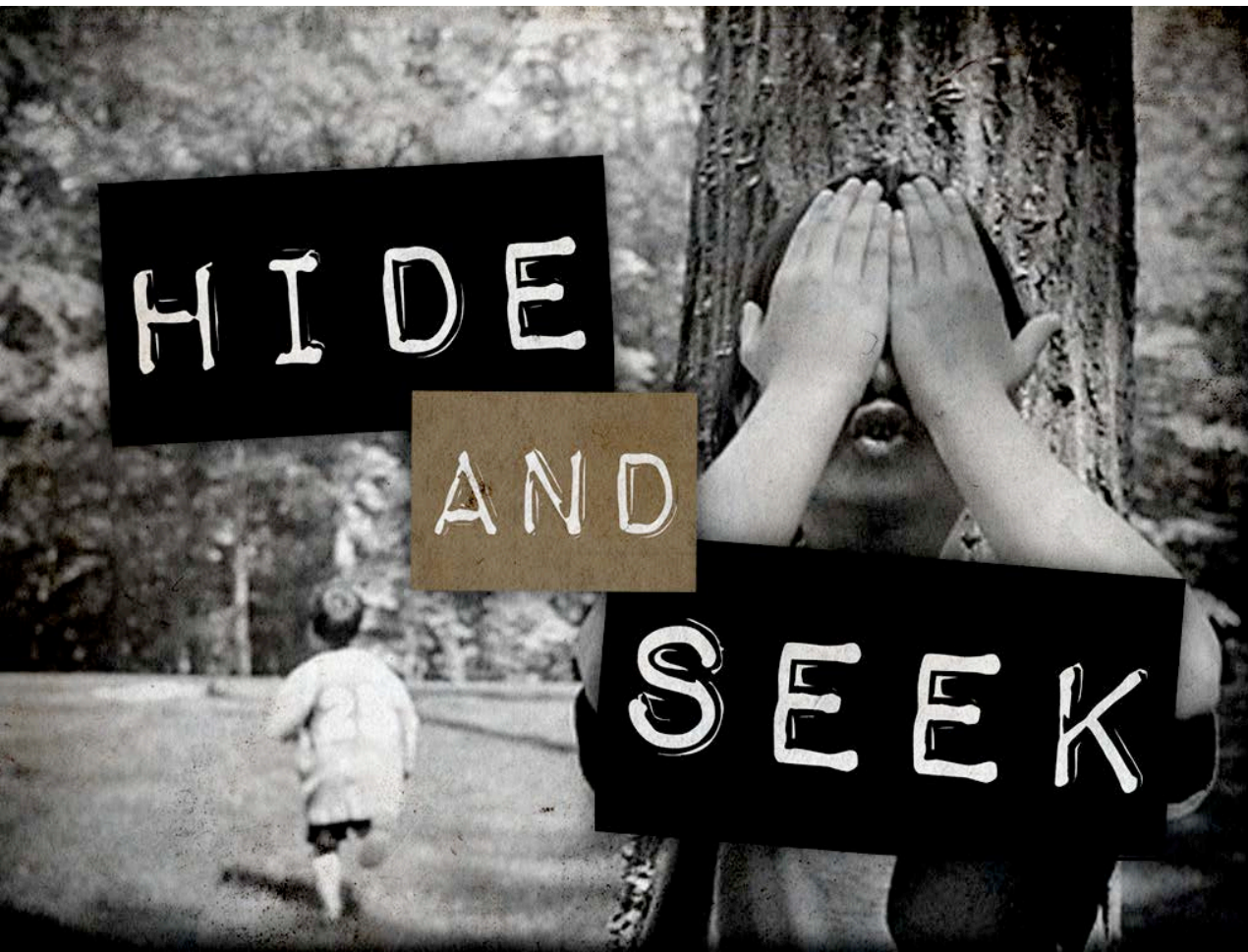

- Reconsiders convictions when confronted with contrary evidence
- Congenial when confronted with disagreement

The Irrational Mind



- Has been taught **WHAT** to think
- Follows dictated morality
- Denies new ideas until approved by authority
- Needs others to think for them
- Uses primitive belief systems to decide issues
- Denies evidence contradicting established beliefs
- Displays anger and contempt for those who disagree with doctrine

Information:

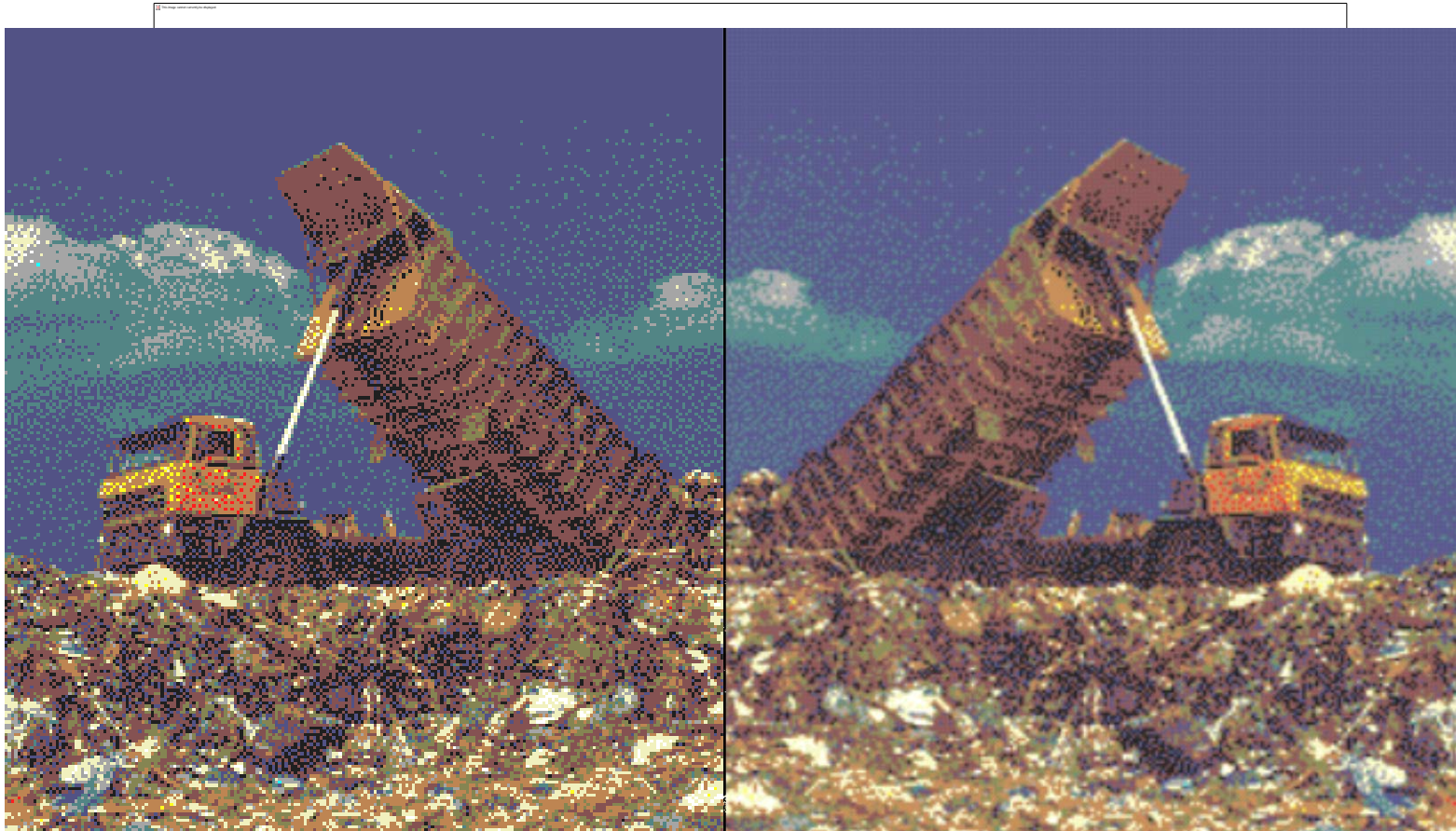
Morning: Sunny; 16 C
