2.6 PRIVILEGES

The privileges for working in the COBISS3/Cataloguing software module enable:

- access to COBISS3/Cataloguing, and data viewing and printing (CAT)
- shared cataloguing of monographs (books), and the creation of collection-level records and records for performed works (CAT_A_MON)
- shared cataloguing of component parts (CAT_B1_ART)
- shared cataloguing of continuing resources (CAT_B2_CON)
- shared cataloguing of serials (CAT_NEWSER)
- shared cataloguing of non-book material (CAT_C_NBM)
- shared cataloguing of antiquarian material (CAT_D_ANT)
- downloading records from the Library of Congress Online Catalog and the WorldCat database (CAT_NEWMARC21)
- creating and editing full authority records for personal names and downloading records from the LC/NAF database (CAT_NEWPN)
- creating and editing full authority records for corporate bodies (CAT_NEWCB)
- editing all authority records including those adopted by another library (CAT_CONOR)
- batch linking bibliographic records with CONOR or SGC authority records (CAT_LINKAU)
- downloading and editing records in the CORES database (CAT_NEWCORES)
- changing properties of fields and subfields, setting up and editing counters (CAT_EDITTYPE)
- exporting bibliographic records (CAT_EXPORT)
- verifying typology of documents/works (CAT_LOCKTD)
- access to the METADAT database (CAT_METADAT)
- creating, editing and confirming records for subject headings privilege for verifying records (CAT_COSUB)
- creating and editing records for subject headings privilege for editing records (**CAT SUBRED**)
- entering links with SGC authority records into bibliographic records (CAT_SUBLINK)

Within the COBISS3/Holdings software module, it is possible to work with bibliographic records to a limited extent:

- record download from shared database to local database (CAT_RCT)
- editing a limited set of bibliographic data in the local database (subfields 100e, 330az, 539a, 610az, 675bs, 992by, 9930 to 9939) (CAT_610)
