Data Export Tool updates description

V11.0, 10–11 December 2022

- Bug fixes:
 - in the structure of the name of the file containing the exported data;
 - for the storage period of exported files.

V6.28-00, 27–28 February 2021

- The following attributes were removed from the list of attributes in the **Transactions** class: "Inclusion of each transaction in visit statistics", "Transaction ID", "Considering transaction in visit statistics", and "Transaction type".

V6.27-00, 17–18 October 2020

- If you store the data export to jobs, the file name you specified during the data export (e.g. *exportDatabase_Inventory_Book_<running no.>*) will now also be displayed in front of the current job number in the *exportDatabase* job name.

V6.26-00, 25–26 April 2020

- The name of the file with exported data now also includes the username of the system user who exported the data in front of the random 7-digit number.

V6.24-00, 7–8 December 2019

- In the **Data export** window, the **Add subfields** button was renamed (previously: **Add subfield**) and the **User attributes** button was added. This button enables to add user attributes in the **Bibliographic record** class, the **Authority record (CONOR)** class, the **Authority record (SGC)** class and the **CORES** class that you had previously defined by using the **Hit list formats** method. The added user attribute is placed after the attributes of each class in the Cataloguing software module.
- All attributes are now displayed in the list of attributes in all the class of the Cataloguing software module.
- The retention period for exported files has been changed; the files are now kept for seven days (previously: three days).

- If you store the data export to jobs (*job exportDatabase_<run. no.>*) and specify that the job should be performed periodically (e.g. *every day*), the name of the file with the exported data will contain a new random 7-digit number each time.
- The subfields you added in the **Bibliographic record** class, the **Authority record (CONOR)** class, the **Authority record (SGC)** class and the **CORES** class and which are included in the definition, are now also saved to the saved data export definition.
- Bug fixes:
 - when selecting a saved data export definition, the links to the relationships with one-to-many-ratio (1:M) are no longer duplicated;
 - when filtering data on level 2 relationships.

V6.23-01, 12 September 2019

- From now on, the text file with the exported data is only available for three (3) days. In the notification you receive by e-mail once the data export is complete, click the link to the exported data file as soon as possible, open the file and save it to the designated folder on your computer.

V6.22-00, 8–9 June 2019

- The attribute "Duplicate (d\d)" is added in the list of attributes of the **Field 996/997** class.

V6.21-00, 16–17 March 2019

- The attribute "Visit by status" is removed from the attributes list of the **Transactions** class.
